Then the process of adapting to a new culture and new customs began, but also triggered a series of emotions that would mark her forever.

The longing of her grandparents and her friends in Morocco, the concern for economic difficulties, the process of adapting to the new school, the controversial participation in sports events or the latent racism in the first job interviews are just some of the episodes that Laila, with her enormous sensibility, recounts in first person.

This is how we discover the life of a girl who lives on horseback from two worlds that she assumes naturally and feels as her own.


A graphic novel set in a very special school, where nothing is what it seems...
